2. THE RETIRING TOWN MAYOR'S REMARKS

The Mayor welcomed civic guests, councillors, public and press. He welcomed new and established members returning to Council and thanked those who had not been re-elected for their service.

He has attended two CEC Mayor Making Ceremonies during his year in office and yesterday saw Cllr Birkill become Mayor for CEC, Cllr Edgar became Deputy and Sandbach Town Councillor, Sam Corcoran became Leader of the Council; congratulations and good wishes were tendered.

Members were reminded that they are volunteers, but that they are not alone, as there are many community groups within Sandbach that contribute to the culture of the environment.

He referred to the challenges of the adopted Local Plan, which will see an increase in the population of Sandbach of 40% by 2030 and stated that we need to work together in managing this.

During the year he has attended many events throughout Cheshire East and the old county of Cheshire to mark the end of WW1. These include the Edwin Firth and Foden's Concerts, the upgraded Middlewich War Memorial, Tatton Park – When the Lights Go Out and a Concert of Remembrance involving the music and poetry from Sandbach Schools.

Musically, Crewe Male Voice Choir celebrated its 60 years, concerts of the Sandbach Concert Series and Sandbach Choral Society were attended. A Celebration Concert was hosted for Foden's Band when they won the National Championships; Foden's Band also played at the Town's Party in the Park.

Within Sandbach, he had had the privilege to open the newly refurbished Market Hall, with its historic Sandbach shutter graphics from the Minshull Archive. He had awarded prizes to participants in the Christmas Market competition and to entrants of the Transport Festival. Finally, not forgetting the opening of the new, but very wet, play equipment at Wheelock Park.

Sincere thanks were given to Thomas Shepherd, representing Sandbach Churches Together as the Mayor's Honorary Chaplain and to Dennis Robinson, Town Crier. Thanks too to the Town Clerk and her staff for their hard work during the year.

At the beginning of the year, the Mayor pledged to support the encouragement of learning and playing musical instruments for residents of school age. Concerts of the Lions Youth Brass and the Spotlight Series have been attended, along with a music for youth competition held during the Transport Festival and a Christmas Concert at St Mary's by the two secondary schools. The Mayor reported that music appears to be thriving among the young people of Sandbach; supported by gifted tutors and experienced musicians.

Being a dementia champion was also a priority through an initiative started by the Sandbach Partnership, using knowledge gained from other communities, especially Alsager, the aim of which is to make life better for those living with dementia. This initiative progressed and saw the formation of 'Dementia Friendly Sandbach', Cllr Hovey will continue to take an active role.

A modest cheque will be passed to both the Sandbach Dementia Group and the Sandbach Concert Series to support these causes.

The new Mayor paid tribute to the retiring Mayor, Cllr Richard Hovey.

Richard has missed just 6 of 51 public meetings; for each of these occasions he was attending to his civic duties elsewhere.

He has been an excellent Mayor and has done his utmost to attend everything that he has been invited to. As the chair at Council meetings, he has always kept order and remained impartial, he has spent a great deal of time preparing for meetings, which has paid off in the Chamber.

He has kept the office project moving and now working with the Clerk to deliver improvements to the Town Hall Office.

He opened the refurbished Market Hall following a project led by Cllr Forster.

He hosted a concert to celebrate the successes of Foden's Band and to raise awareness and re-establish pride in the band's link to Sandbach.

He passionately embraced his role on the Dementia Support Group and plans to continue his work with this Group.

He always takes a great interest in planning matters and despite not being the chair of planning over the past 12 months, has not missed a single planning meeting. He takes the time to inspect applications and as necessary, view the sites to be developed.

He has attended over 70 mayoral engagements, of note have been the Boys School Awards Ceremony, an Anti-Bullying Conference and events supporting the Dementia Friendly Group.

He has judged the Best Dressed Christmas Shop Window, which this year went to William R Shoes and was the 'car' judge at the transport festival – no mean feat.

He has excellent qualities: he is caring, thoughtful, listens to and considers others. He is passionate about Sandbach and a true gentleman.

We are all pleased to see that he has been re-elected.

A framed certificate of appreciation for the past year and a small gift from the new Mayor was also presented.
