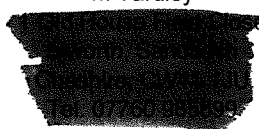

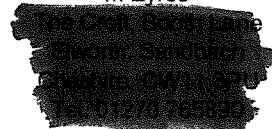

## **Q2 Summary of project**

Elworth Cricket Club has developed its on field playing facilities in recent years and is well regarded as a community sports facility. Participation has increased, especially for junior players and in particular girls' cricket. Our aim now is to take the next logical step and rejuvenate the buildings infrastructure by extending the clubroom and refurbishing existing amenities. Currently we provide first class facilities for outdoor recreation, but these high standards are not being matched by those of the building amenity. By extending and refurbishing the amenities, in particular the toilets, kitchen and clubroom we will immediately address the demands from existing and potential users to make improvements. This will be a first step towards transforming the club. We are seeking to provide a facility that connects people, reaches the standards and matches the needs of existing and potential members and community groups to use for meetings, social activities and recreation.

## **Q3 How does the project meet these priorities?**

### **What we'll deliver:**

Clean modernised toilet facilities  
Refreshed and functional kitchen space  
Rejuvenated and extended clubroom

### **Why it's a great idea:**

We will provide new and improved facilities that will immediately be more attractive for the local community, offering availability all year round. We will encourage local residents, schools and businesses to make better use of the sports and social opportunities that will be available to them. The refurbishment will replace old and outdated sanitary-ware and furniture with new items. New floor-coverings in all areas will improve the look and make cleaning and maintenance easier. This will create a more attractive and comfortable space for existing and potential users. We want to realise the full potential the club has to support the increased local housing base. There have been over 1,250 new homes over the last 10 years in Ettiley Heath, Elworth Farm, Abbeyfields and Booth Lane. The project is a new and exciting drive to transform the cricket club into a first-class community centre. One to join our sports facilities in improving physical and/or mental wellbeing.
