4. REQUEST FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF SANDBACH TOWN PARK AND NEWALL AVENUE PLAY AREA

It was agreed to carry out a feasibility study/consultation and not pursue obtaining quotes for a skatepark in Sandbach Town Park. Several possible sites were suggested including, alongside Mortimer Drive Play Area, on the open space between Betchton Close (Tatton Drive estate) and Old Mill Road bypass.

The following sites were suggested for further consultation: Sandbach Town Park, Newall Avenue, Green Street, Church Lane Play Area, open space between Betchton Close (Tatton Drive estate) and Old Mill Road bypass.

ACTION Sam Corcoran to ascertain the ownership of the open space between Betchton Close (Tatton Drive estate) and Old Mill Road bypass.

The question was raised over whether to have a skatepark or pump track or both. It was agreed that this will depend on the site and the amount of room available
