# 3. TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE EVENTS SUB-COMMITTEE HELD 25 FEBRUARY AND 30 JUNE 2020.

Approval of both sets of minutes was deferred until the next meeting of the Sub-Committee due to an inquorate number of members in attendance from both previous meetings.

Instead of one event in the Summer, Members favoured the idea of multiple separate events throughout the year which targeted the same demographic as the Family Fun Day. This gives families something cheap/free to do and to help with mental wellbeing during the current time.

The Events and Business Promotion Officer noted that she has already organised a program of lots of little events that fit into this criteria in the Town Hall for 2021 which could be integrated.

Members requested that the Clerk of the Meeting contacts Everybody Sport to see if they would like to get involved in any way with a number of little events in the park. This item will come back to the next meeting for more detail.

# Resolved: That

With reference to the above and in light of Covid-19 social distancing restrictions, many events that were planned for the 75th VE/VJ anniversary and some AFD dates this year, have now or are being moved to various dates in 2021. At present, we have an extremely wide range of WWII demonstrations, displays, re-enactments, aircraft, tanks, military vehicles, children's activities, workshops and entertainment available, so if you are moving or considering moving dates to next year please contact us to discuss your requirements. Clearly all this depends on what happens with the Coronavirus and government advice for 2021, but at present everything is possible and activities can be booked on a provisional basis!

If you also want to consider any activities, even at this late stage for this year's Remembrance Day/Poppy Day, please do contact us as soon as possible.

For next year, please see below for a snapshot of what's contained in the attached proposals and some new activities listed below:

# WWII and 1940's Home Front Events (please see attached proposal):

For 2021, we have an extremely wide range and every growing array of activities available to provide entertainment for 1940's events, including WWII battle re-enactments, static displays, demonstrations and arena events. Our programmes can include, ack ack and searchlight battery display, cameos, living history presentations, walkabout characters (spives, land army, billeting offices, ARP wardens, policemen and Winston Churchill to name but a few), home guard, Life on the 'Home Front', children's make and take home activities and workshops, 1940's music, dance, theatre, etc all for your event. We can also provide maritime elements and displays, such as beach landings, craft and combat for displays that are required to take place in maritime locations or on lakes and rivers. For aerial displays, we can provide period aircraft, but also airfield ground crews, pilots, airfield defence personnel, military police, period vehicles (cars, jeeps, trucks, etc), static Spitfires and downed German WWII aircraft. Don't forget we also have a new WWII Cinema Showing achieve film footage of the period and a 'Salute to the 40's Show!

# The WWII Company HQ:

A two person character interoperation, using large maps and military models explaining about some of the greatest battles of WWII. The attached details explain brief details about the day. A 4m x 3m space is required.

# **WWII Interpretation:**

A one person interpretation looking at home life in the 1940's, with dressing up and hands on activities. The day will also include looking at The Home Guard; The effects of the Blitz; The Battle of Britain; Serving in the Forces; Spies and spying; Rationing. We may be able to run some activities outside but would like some indoor space to keep the materials safe from the weather.

### **WWII Mounted Home Guard:**

We can also now provide WWII Mounted Home Guard (Horse and Rider/s) for shows and arena performances, meet and greet and for displays.

# **Swift Training Rifles:**

Swift Training Rifle was a rifle shooting training device made in Great Britain during the Second World War. This rifle did not actually fire a cartridge, but shot out a forked probe that punctured a paper target barely an inch from the "muzzle". Have a go activity for children.

# Women's Land Army Milking Machine:

Learn about the Women's Land Army and have a go at the type of 'training machines' used. This all comes with either WWII code breakers, OR peg toys, dolls, bomber & fighter planes making for children.

# Life in the Merchant Navy During WWII:

A WW2 Merchant Navy officer will inform you as to how he survived and how the German UBoats tried to stop supplies reaching the Allies.

# A VE Day Story:

Discover how a civilian wakes up with his family to find out that VE Day has finally arrived. The story is around the lead up to the day, all the anticipation, and the news leading up to the day, and then what it was like to live through those 2 days. It lasts around 30 mins could be done 3 or 4 times in a day as a timetabled event.

The time slots will be a couple of hours and difference themes available for male / female/ children.


My vision is something like the below for the look and feel.
